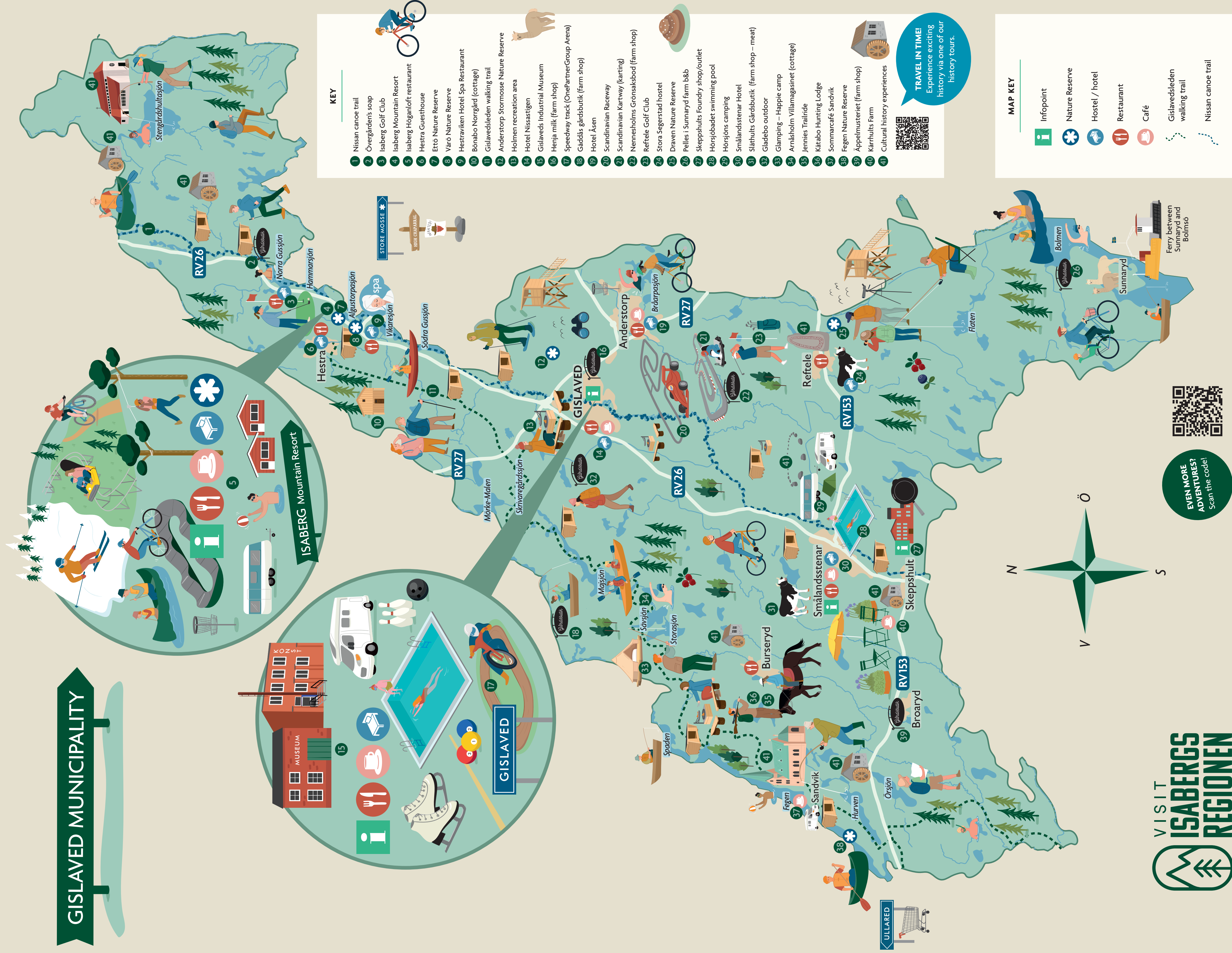

- Discover Happie Camp, a magical forest retreat hidden in the wild.
- Roast marshmallows under the stars at one of our wind shelters.
- Experience the Småland mountains with Isaberg's 11 ski slopes of varying difficulty, ski school, cozy cabins, and après-ski.

Exciting History Along the Nissan River

Along the Nissan River, you can find many historical remnants from different time periods, including timber rafting, mills, and ironworks. When industrialization and the railway arrived, the region transformed from a poor part of Småland into a thriving community. The geographical location and the inventive spirit of the Småland people have made the municipality a highly industrialized area.

At Gislaved's Industrial Museum, housed in the 100-year-old Remfabriken (Belt Factory), you can explore the area's fascinating industrial history.

Fabriksrundan – A Unique Shopping Experience

Fabriksrundan, held every October, offers a unique opportunity to visit the iconic factories of the Gnosjö region and shop for products directly from the manufacturers. Here, you can find showroom samples, discounted items, and end-of-line products at fantastic prices. You can also join guided tours, learn more about the production process, and discover why Småland-made products are renowned worldwide.

Welcome to southern Sweden's largest bike park
At Isaberg there are more than 25 marked mountain bike trails that offer many beautiful miles both on and around the mountain. For those who prefer going downhill, there is a network of trails that wind down the mountain. The 6-chair lift takes you and the bike all the way up to the top of the mountain.

Scandinavia's largest pump track

For those who want to develop their technique or just have a little fun, there is also a 6 hectare technical area and an absolutely awesome 2,500 square metre pump track of world class with lots of opportunities for both young and old mountain bikers.
